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Rayonier closes properties for public access in California, Oregon and Washington

POULSBO, Washington – Due to the current weather and fire hazard conditions, Rayonier has decided to **close all public access to its forestland properties in California, Oregon and Washington** until after the 4th of July Holiday, at which time we will reevaluate conditions.

These properties include lands owned by Rayonier, Pope Resources, Olympic Property Group (OPG), and managed by Olympic Resource Management (ORM). The town of Port Gamble remains open. We continue to monitor weather conditions on a regular basis and may determine to open or close forestland properties on an area-by-area basis.
